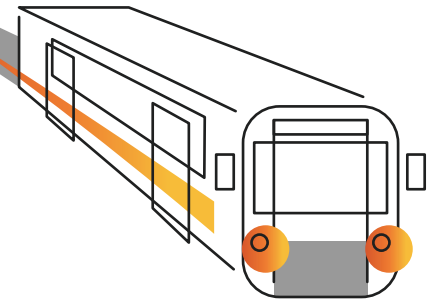
Passengers carried on the A Line in August 2019, the busiest month to date. **That's more than 24,000 per day!**

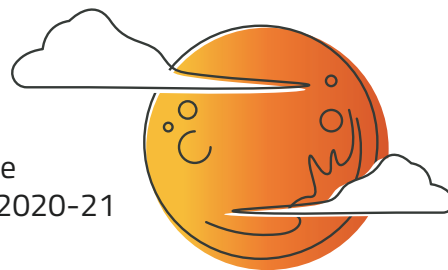

During the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, **Denver retained 45% of pre-covid ridership numbers.** This was the best in the nation for commuter rail properties.

Denver Transit Partners (DTP):

DTP partnered with Regional Transportation District (RTD) to finance, design, build, operate and maintain the A, B and G lines under a Concession Agreement through 2044.



Economic Impact

RTD estimates the economic impact of its DTP commuter rail project at:

\$2 billion+

in direct economic impact (the cost of building and staffing the project)

\$8 billion+

in indirect economic impact to the metro Denver area
