What Will You Do?

In this position you are the first line supervisor of the Communication Technicians and will be responsible for the daily inspection, testing and repair of the commuter railroad network and communications infrastructure. Assigns and directs daily work activities of the Communication Techs and ensures compliance with all safety rules and regulations as per company policy. Provides guidance and clear expectations by coaching, developing and training staff to enhance productivity and ensure department goals are met. Performs efficiency tests as per regulation and requirements. Maintains timely and accurate records of inspections, repairs, calibration tests in Asset Works Linear Focus module. Ensures staff receive required training to perform all functions of their job safely. Manages the time and attendance of work crews. Provides coaching and counseling regarding employee performance. Provides input and recommendations regarding employment and disciplinary decisions. Manages the administration of tests and safety inspections of train control communication equipment per FRA Part 234 and 236. Reviews and analyzes maintenance activity reports for trends in repairs, equipment failures and parts usage to determine if corrective action is needed and adjusting to meet department needs. Develop and produce reports as required and requested by department manager. Oversees the work required to align, adjust, and calibrate instruments by testing equipment per specifications. Ensures availability of supplies and tools necessary for the technicians to perform work assigned. Develop, review and evaluate departmental budget needs and requests. Coordinate with contractors in maintaining the OCC system. Complete all other duties as assigned.

This is a safety sensitive position subject to the rules & regulations of the Federal Railroad Administration and their Drug & Alcohol policy.

What Will You learn?

Our Communication Supervisor play an important part in keeping our locomotives on the move. We will teach you the dynamic workings of our commuter railroad network, as well as the communication infrastructure.

What You Need to Bring: (Position Requirements)

Must have a High School diploma or GED required; Associates degree in electronic/computer technology or related field and work experience required, Bachelor's degree preferred. Minimum 2 years of supervisory/lead experience required. Minimum 3-year experience working electronic diagnosis and repair preferred. Experience in railroad train control inspection, maintenance and repair preferred. Ability to prioritize and accomplish multiple tasks with minimal supervision. Ability to work nights, holidays and weekends, including working overtime as needed. Ability to instruct and cross train staff on inspections, maintenances, testing and repair assignments. Must possess a valid state driver's license. Must be eligible to work in the U.S. and successfully pass a pre-employment background check, drug and alcohol screening and be willing to comply with the DTO Drug and Alcohol Policy.

Physical Requirements:

Candidates can expect to be in a cab for much of their shift you may be required to perform the following physical activities.

- Must be able to climb towers up to 40 feet high.
- Stand for sustained periods of time and work in outside environmental conditions such as extreme heat or cold.
