What Will You Do?

- In this position you will be responsible for the labor intensive day-to-day track and infrastructure repairs and maintenance on the commuter rail system.
- Maintaining and inspect the trackway features such as ballast, sub-ballast, ties and rails as well as track bolts and other rail fastening hardware and infrastructure.
- Remove dust, dirt, grease, snow, ice, and waste material from tracks, switches and structures.
- Paint machines or equipment to prevent corrosion. Bend and cut rail and replace rail sections.
- Load and unload work trucks.
- Operate heavy equipment, such as, bobcats, backhoes, bucket trucks, and any others as needed.
- Perform general demolition and concrete work, such as, cutting, pouring, finishing.

- Clear clogged track drains and culverts.
- Perform weed and vegetation control and removal on the right of way.

This is a safety sensitive position subject to the rules & regulations of the Federal Railroad Administration and their Drug & Alcohol policy.

What You Need to Bring: (Position Requirements)

- Must have a High School Diploma or GED required.
- Mechanical aptitude with at least 1 year of construction or track work experience preferred.
- Ability to comply with all safety sensitive job requirements and testing.
- Must possess a valid state driver's license; be able to obtain Class A CDL.
- Must pass a pre-employment physical examination.
- Must be eligible to work in the U.S. and successfully pass a pre-employment background check, drug and alcohol screening and be willing to comply with the DTO Drug and Alcohol Policy.

Physical Requirements:

Candidates can expect to be outside for much of their shift you may be required to perform the following physical activities.

- Ability to perform heavy lifting-over 100 lb. /over 50 lb. frequently/over 20 lb. constantly.
- Stand for sustained periods of time and work in outside environmental conditions such as extreme heat or cold.
