Position Summary:

The Systems Administrator is responsible for the configuration and maintenance of the Company's servers and network infrastructure. This position will assist with all IT related assignments and projects and support end-users.

Description of Duties:

- Configure and maintain VM Ware implementations, including but not limited to, creating, testing and updating windows settings, firewalls, Active Directory user accounts and group policies
- Troubleshoot issues, read logs and exception files to understand and resolve applications and software issues
- Setup and configure servers that integrate with other applications, such as, TMDS, HASTUS, and AssetWorks
- Design and setup new controls and indicators of code lines in CAD system
- Configure and maintain communication systems between local applications, wayside and onboarding devices
- Troubleshoot and resolve positive train control (PTC) issues
- Configure and maintain data backup and recovery systems (i.e. Quest Rapid Recovery and VM Ware SRM)

- Complete all other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in engineering, Information Systems or related field from a four-year accredited college or university or equivalent years of education and experience
- 3 or more years of experience working with CAD system software; Specific experience in Wabtec TMDS with knowledge of control, communication, CODE, and BOS servers required
